KING EDWARD VII SCHOOL GCSE Results 2026

Students at King Edward VII School are celebrating achieving excellent GCSE results this summer in response to challenging courses and examinations.

74% of students achieved grades 4 – 9 in English and Mathematics
58% of students achieved grades 5 – 9 in English and Mathematics
19% of students achieved grades 7 – 9 (A - A*) in English and Mathematics
76% of all GCSE passes are at grade 4 or above (grade C and above)
26% of all GCSE passes are at grade 7 or above (A/A*)



Linda Gooden, Headteacher, has shared that:

'We are incredibly proud of the excellent GCSE results achieved by our students this year. These results reflect their hard work, resilience and determination, together with the unwavering support of our dedicated staff, parents and families. These results demonstrate the high standards of achievement and ambition that continue to characterise our learning community.

We look forward to welcoming many of our students into the Sixth Form in September and for those who will be pursuing opportunities elsewhere, we wish them continued success.'
